NZQA-accredited qualification program

◆ Leisure Sports (Golf Focus) - NZ National Diploma Level 5 (NZQA Level 5)

Entry Requirements:

- Students aged 14 or older, both junior and senior high school students, are eligible to apply.

Length of Study:

- Two years.

Graduation Benefits:

- Earn the NZQA Level 5 Diploma and the NZPGA Coach Certificate, recognized globally.
- Graduates can pursue further studies for a bachelor's degree or master's degree.
- Employment – graduates could consider working in golf related roles including tournament golfer, golf coaching, golf caddying, golf club official, golf development officer, golf shop manager or golf equipment sales representative. Other working environments could include an event Manager, sports co-ordinator, managing Sports Academies, managing sports teams, Sports/Recreation Centre Manager.

◆ **Leisure Sports (Golf Direction) (New Zealand Certificate Level 4 in Sports, Recreation, and Exercise (Multi-Sectors))**

Entry Requirements:

- Students aged 14 or older, both junior and senior high school students, are eligible to apply.

Length of Study:

- One year.

- Equip students with the knowledge and skills needed in leisure sports.
- Prepare students for careers in teaching, guiding, and providing leisure sports services.
- Train students in market development, operation, and management of the leisure sports industry.
- Develop skills for planning, designing, and organizing leisure sports products.
- Prepare students to work in leisure sports tourism.
- Achieve a professional level as a golf coach or athlete.
